## Q-Shelter (Quonset tent)

Q-Shelters have been deployed in disaster relief and humanitarian aid missions all over the world including the tsunami-devastated areas of Indonesia, Sri Lanka, and India, in the Gulf Coast after Hurricane Katrina and after last year's major earthquake in Jogjakarta Indonesia.

The pre-assembled Q-Shelters take only 20 minutes to erect, weigh 120 pounds and are shipped in two 60-pound parcels – each of which a single individual can carry to the point of use.

The design of the Q-Shelter also allows shelter production from small inexpensive Clip Kits to be done in-country so that wages can be paid to local workers and local materials can be purchased for the required poles.

The Q-Shelter was designed specifically to utilize the flame-retardant, UV-resistant, heavy-gauge plastic sheeting that is delivered to every disaster location by the USAID, the UN and the Red Cross for conversion into self-supporting structures.
